
EMMER GREEN SURGERY PATIENT NEWSLETTER – SEPTEMBER EDITION



THE NHS APP PROVIDES A SIMPLE AND SECURE WAY FOR PEOPLE TO ACCESS A RANGE OF NHS SERVICES ON THEIR TABLET OR SMARTPHONE.

The NHS app is owned and run by the NHS. It can be accessed by anyone aged 13 and over registered with an NHS GP surgery in England.

Once you have verified your identity in the app, you will have easy, 24/7 access to a growing range of health services and information.

What does the NHS app do? View your GP health record, medical history, test results, allergies, and medicines. Once the Surgery goes live in October.

Register your organ donation decision, take part in health research, order repeat prescriptions & nominate a pharmacy.

Book appointments with your GP surgery and hospital appointments all in one place.

Send and receive messages, get advice and information, find NHS services, and check your NHS number.

Sophie our NHS app ambassador will be on hand to help you set this up and answer any questions you may have. Keep an eye out for her in our waiting room.



The NHS app does not store any Patient Data. It lets you view your health information held by your GP and other health care professionals.

MONTHLY STATISTICS FOR AUGUST - VIA EMMER GREEN SURGERY WEBSITE

COVID & FLU VACCINES AUTUM/WINTER PROGRAMME.

Eligibility Cohorts for COVID

Residents in a care home for older adults.

All adults aged 65 and over.

Persons aged 18-64 in a clinical risk group. (as per the green book)

Frontline health and social care workers.

Persons aged 12-64 who are household contacts of people with immunosuppression.

Persons aged 12-64 who are carers and staff working in care homes.

Eligibility Cohorts for Seasonal Flu vaccination

Those aged 65 and over

Those aged 6 months to under 65 in a clinical risk group (as per the green book)

Pregnant Women

All children aged 2 or 3 years on 31st August 2023

Carers & Front-line workers in a social care setting.

Close contact of anyone who is immunocompromised.

NHS England and JCVI have advised all GP surgeries to Co-administer these vaccines to maximise clinical protection over the winter months when COVID & FLU are most likely to be prevalent. With this in mind we will be running a COVID and flu clinic for the under 65's on the 30th September 2023 then the following weekend an over 65's clinic on the 7th October. PLEASE DO NOT call the surgery. You will be invited in due course.
